### **TERRY CONNOLLY FRIEND OF JESSUP AWARD**

The “Friend of Jessup Award” was established ten years ago to honour those individuals from the judiciary, government, and academia who have been of tremendous assistance and support to the Jessup Moot and have given of their time to promote the Jessup Moot either as coaches, judges, or as participants. In 2008 the Award was renamed the “Terry Connolly Friend of Jessup Award” to pay tribute to Justice Terry Connolly of the ACT Supreme Court, a man taken much too early in life who, from his law student days onward, was a Jessup devotee and supported the Jessup in Australia in so many ways. Terry was on the 1979 Australian Team, the first that went to compete in the old International Division in the U.S., and won the International Division and Best Oralist, with Peter Allen, for the University of Adelaide. It is a testament to his involvement that tributes from Australian Jessupers and from Jessupers worldwide, through the International Law Student Association, poured in on the very sad news of his death in 2007.
