

2010 White & Case International Rounds

21-27 March 2010

In March 2010, 126 Jessup teams from 76 countries competed in the White & Case International Rounds, making it the largest competition in the 51-year history of the Jessup. On March 27, the 2010 Final Rounds took place and Australian National University (Australia) won the White & Case Jessup Cup with Columbia University (USA) placing second. The Stephen M. Schwebel Best Oralist Award in the Championship Round was given to Kevin Lin, from Columbia University.

Other awards included:

- Best oralist (Preliminary Rounds): Joe Russo, New York University (USA)
- Best Memorial at the International Rounds: Columbia University (USA)
- Spirit of the Jessup Award: Albiruni University and Kabul University (Afghanistan)

The Final Round Judges included Dame Rosalyn Higgins and Stephen M. Schwebel, former Presidents of the International Court of Justice, and Harold Koh, Legal Advisor to the US Department of State.
